**We do encourage families to attend on Wednesday evening, where each child will receive a blessed medal.**

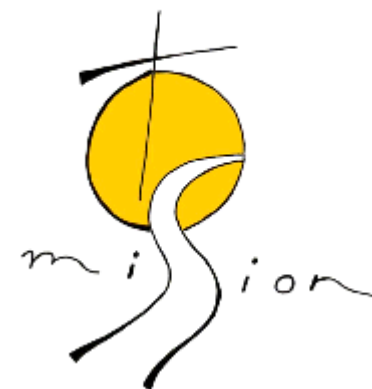
