

The government has announced what everyone expected – that lockdown measures are to be extended. But there is still plenty of scope to reopen many face to face parish activities safely; friendship groups, refreshments after Mass, external bookings, young people's catechesis and parish council meetings. Check the Diocesan Website on Returning, Recovering and Renewing with guidance for parish groups to reopen safely. To protect ourselves we shall continue to practise good housekeeping in a well ventilated Church; social distance and the use of hand sanitiser on entry; no indoor congregational singing; no physical Sign of Peace; no holy water; Holy Communion under one kind. Holy Trinity Church will be open for private worship during the day and you are asked to sanitise the immediate area you have accessed.
