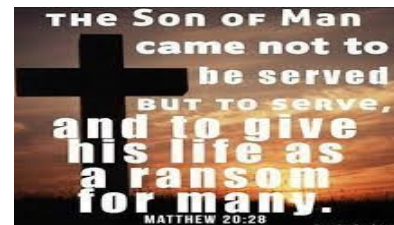

We continue to work together to ensure safety in the daily life of our Church bearing in mind prevailing local conditions for the virus; practising good housekeeping in a well ventilated Church; using hand sanitiser on entry to Church; no physical Sign of Peace; Holy Communion in one kind; holy water available to take home in your own container; congregational singing will resume; you are encouraged to continue to wear face masks.

There is no restriction on numbers attending Baptism, Weddings and Funerals.

Holy Trinity and Our Lady of Victories Churches are open for private worship during the day and you are asked to sanitise the immediate area you have used.

Each November Our Stole of Remembrance is displayed on the Sanctuary at Holy Trinity Church to remember our departed loved ones. If you have lost a family member or friend during the year, please bring a patch of fabric and place in the basket by the Baptismal Font. (6"x4" about the size of a photo, distinctive in design or colour.) Your fabric will be sewn into the Stole to remember them.
